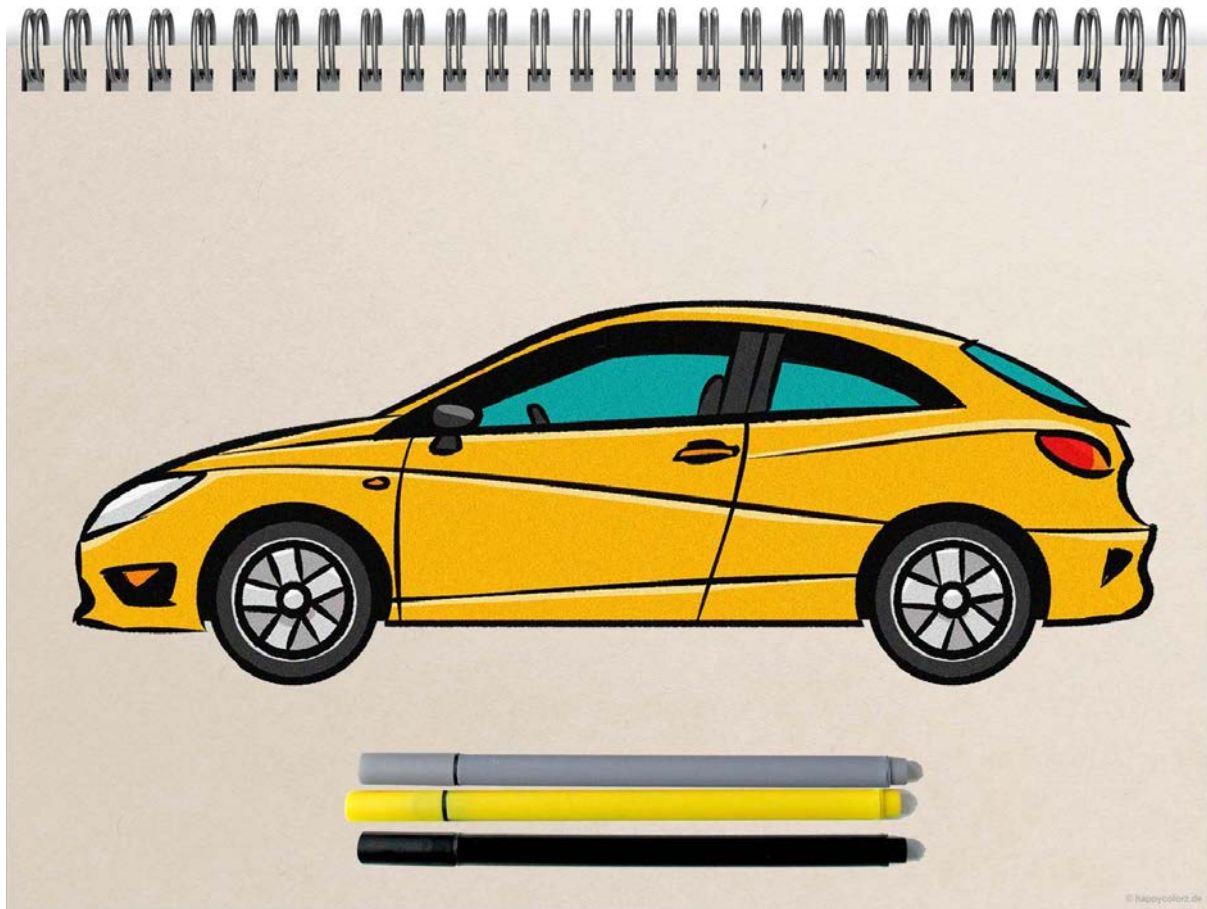


## Car drawing - a step by step guide



a realistic car is not easy. This step-by-step guide can help you accomplish this task. As a man-made machine, a car is characterized by high symmetry and straightness.

In order for your result to look real, you have to draw very precisely. So take your time and study the template carefully.

⚠ For the drawing you need a pencil, a ruler, a compass, an eraser, a drawing pen and colors that suit your taste.

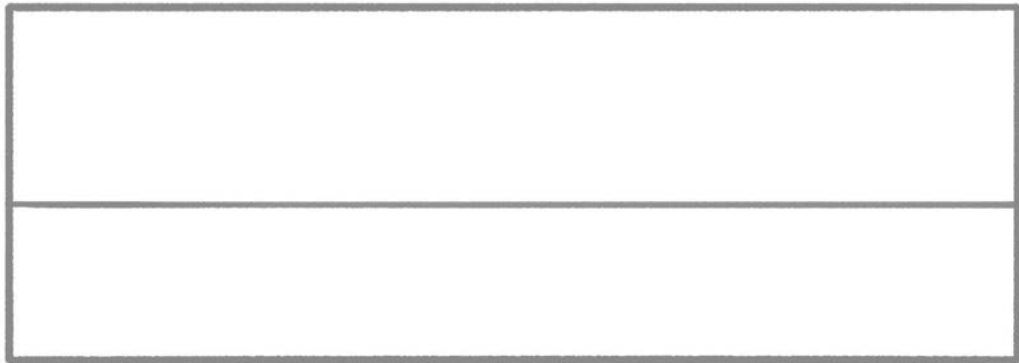


## Step 1: Rectangle as Boundary & Frame

The starting point for your drawing is a narrow rectangle with an aspect ratio of about 2.5:1

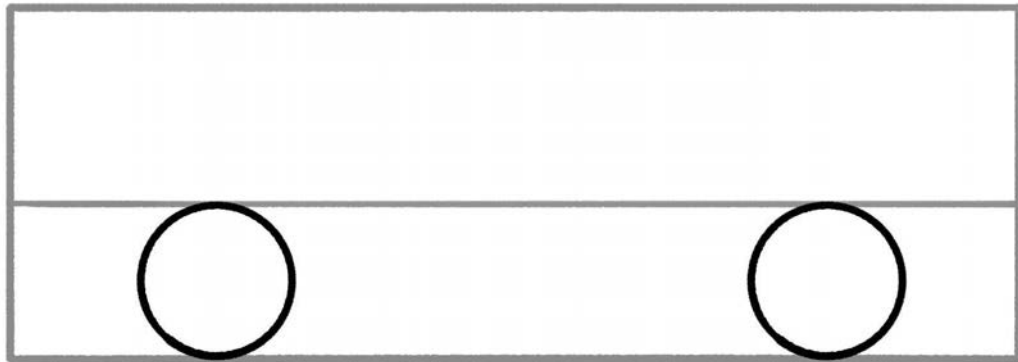

## Step 2: Dividing the Area

Use the pencil to draw a straight horizontal line a little below half the drawing area.

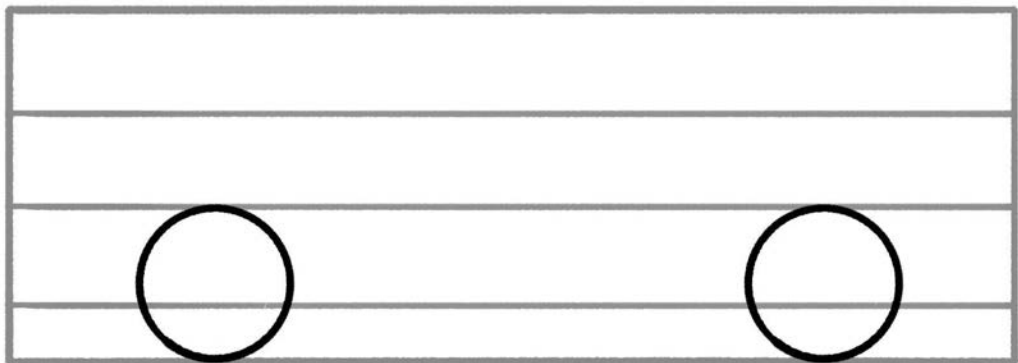

### Step 3: Wheels

In the lower compartment, use a compass to draw the two wheels of the car. Keep enough distance from the edge of the page.

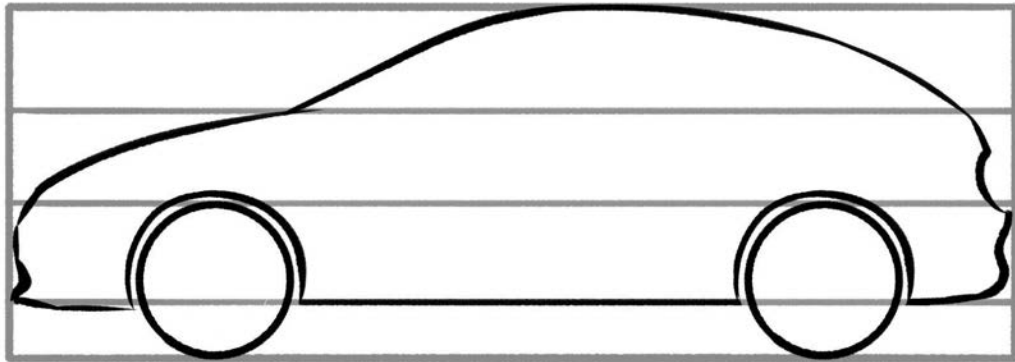

### Step 4: More auxiliary lines

Now draw two more straight auxiliary lines with the pencil. With the first one you divide the area above the first auxiliary line into two equal halves. With the second you add the same area again below the first line.

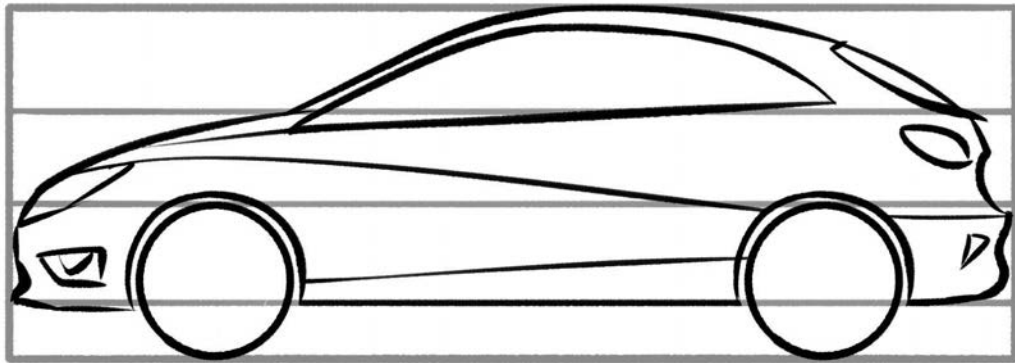

## Step 5: Silhouette of the vehicle

Now use the pencil to outline the shape of the body. Use the guidelines to orient yourself and to keep the proportions. Note the contours of the headlights and bumpers.

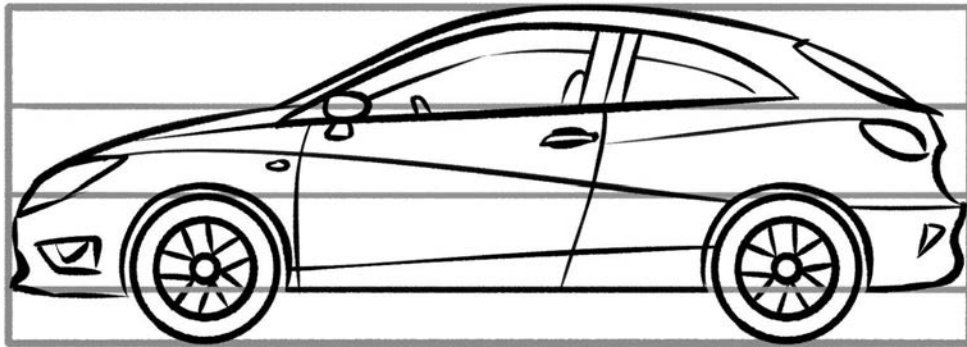


## Step 6: First details

Draw first details such as windows, lights or turn signals. Pay attention to clear and even shapes so that it looks as real as possible in the end.

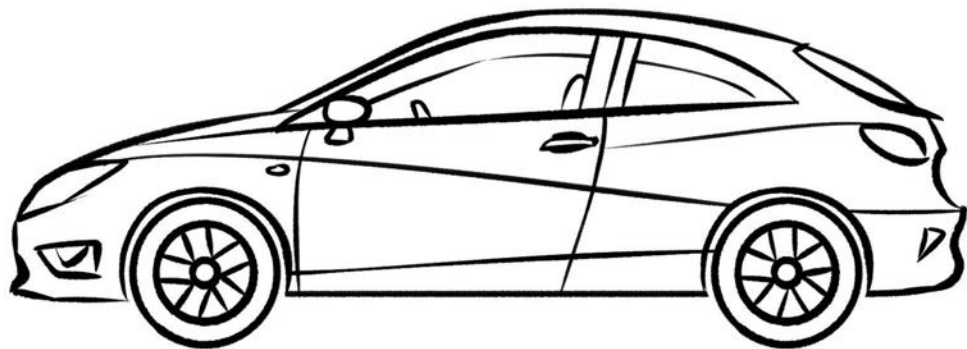


## Step 7: Further refinements

Deepen the details while working cleanly and carefully. Draw rims, side mirrors and contours of the seat and steering wheel.
