
## Draw a simple tree - step by step instructions




This simple and easy-to-implement template is good for beginners and children. The instructions explain step by step how you can draw a tree with just a few strokes.

↑ You will need a harder pencil, an erasable drawing pencil and colored pencils in the colors green, red and brown. Use the hard pencil (HB, H2) to slightly outline the contours. If this doesn't work so well the first time, use the eraser. Trace the contours with the pencil.




Step 1: Silhouette of the trunk and the outer branches

With the pencil, draw the outline of the trunk with two opposite lines. Make sure the lines are mirrored, but still symmetrical and have the same shape. The template shows you how to do this.




**Step 2: The forks** 

Now you draw the forks of the branches. Thats is quite easy. You provide the upper part of the trunk with two arches that curve downwards. These lie side by side and divide the trunk into three branches pointing upwards.



## Step 3: Crown

You put a "lid" on each of the three branches. Then you draw an irregular circle around the upper part of the trunk and thus draw the crown. To make the whole thing look more natural, the circle must not look like it was drawn with a compass, but the edges have a wavy shape, just like a real tree looks. You close the lower part of the trunk with a line.




**Step 4: Spatial Effects** 

You give the tree trunk a few vertical strokes. Again, make sure that the whole thing doesn't look too accurate, but rather looks natural. The lines indicate the structure of the bark.



Step 5: Fruits

Now you draw the apples in the tree. For this you put a few circles in the crown.



## Step 6:

Coloring You put the pencil and pencil aside and grab the colors. Paint the tree trunk brown, the treetop green and the apples red.
