

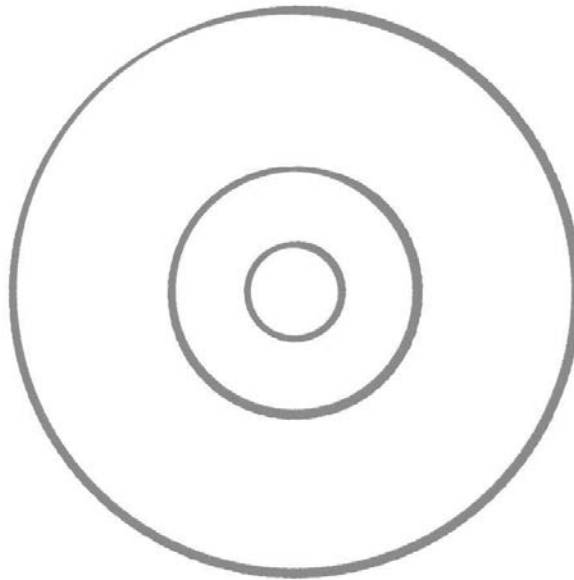
Draw a sunflower - step by step tutorial



You can easily draw this sunflower step by step with the help of this template.

⚠ In addition to a pencil (HB or H2), you need an erasable drawing pen for the contours as well as a pair of compasses and colored pencils.

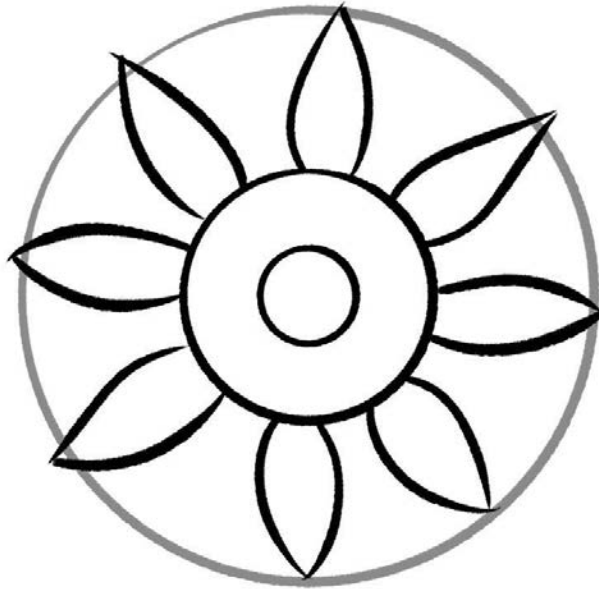

Step 1: Corolla and Petal

We'll start with three circles. You can use a compass or a round object to do this. Draw a large circle with the pencil. Place a small circle right in the middle. Draw a slightly larger circle around this small circle. The instructions will show you exactly what this looks like.

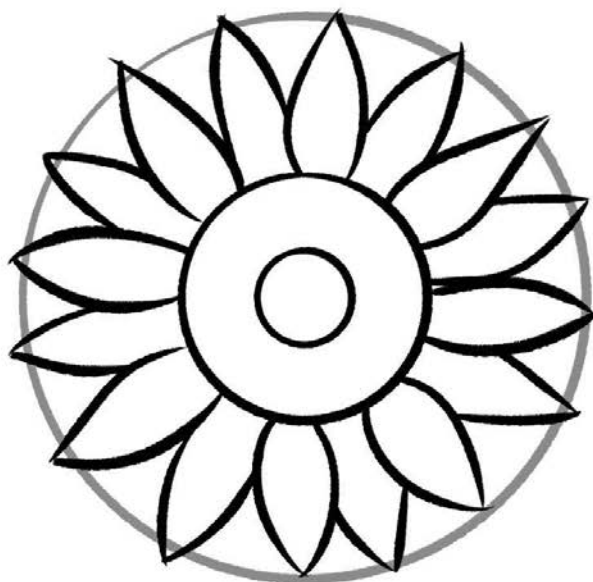

Step 2: Tongue florets

Trace the two smaller circles with the pen. Then you paint eight petals around the middle circle. You can use the pencil for this if you are experienced. Otherwise you use the pencil and correct the drawing if necessary. If the leaves fit perfectly, then you paint the contours with the drawing pen.

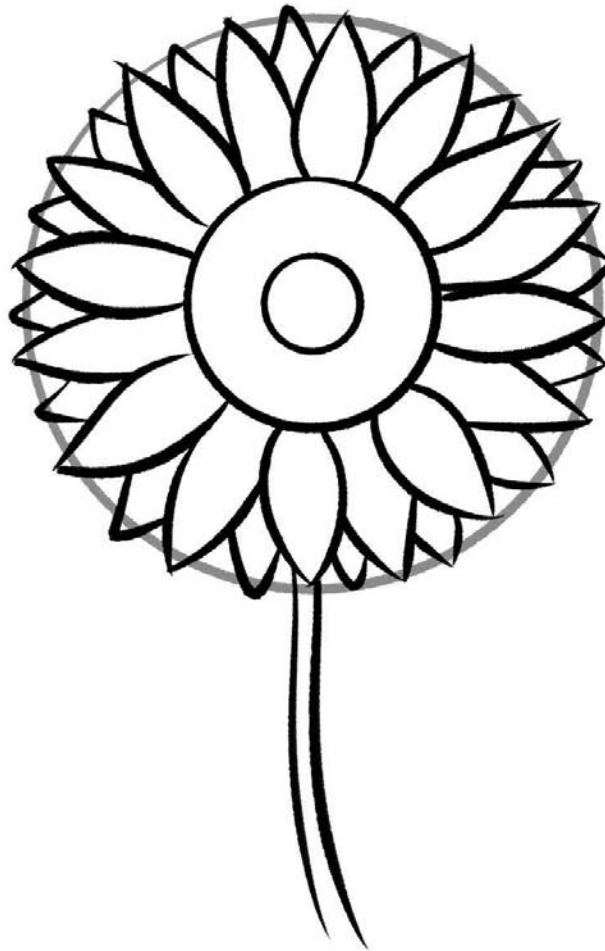

Step 3: More petals

Draw more petals between the existing leaves.

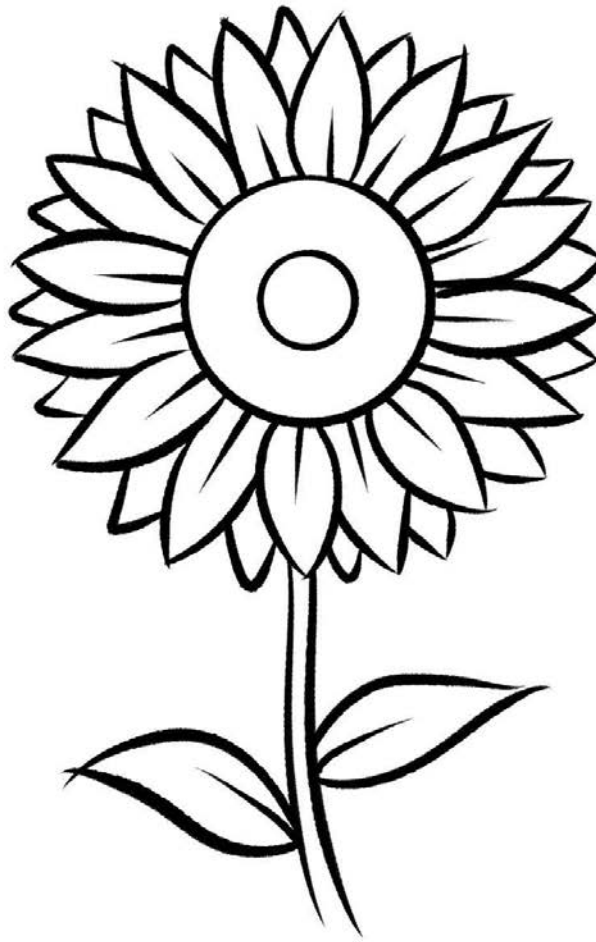

Step 4: Petal wreath

The sunflower gets an even more complex blossom structure. You now paint another row behind the existing petal wreath. Use the outer auxiliary circle as a guide. In addition, your flower will get a stem.

Step 5: Foliage for the stem

You erase the auxiliary lines and give structure to the front petal ring by drawing a line in the middle of each petal. Check out the template for this. Put a leaf on each side of the stem. Here, too, short strokes give the sheet more liveliness.

Step 6: Coloring

You take the colored pencils and color the stem with the two leaves green. The innermost circle of the flower is dark brown, you design the surrounding wreath with a lighter shade of brown. The petals of the sunflower are yellow. Play with the nuances and make your flower more plastic! As you can see in the instructions, the petals are different shades of yellow. The inner petals are lighter than the outer ones.
