Drawing a bike - step by step tutorial



With this template you will draw a bike with all its details step by step. What looks complicated is easy with this template. You just need some patience.


⚠ Have a pencil, eraser, ruler, compass, black permanent drawing pen and colored pencils ready.



Step 1: Auxiliary lines

First, use a pencil and ruler to draw three transverse auxiliary lines. The lines lie straight on top of each other with the same distances. In the template you can see how this works.



Step 2: Wheels and chain


ring Use the compass to draw two equally sized circles in the lines, one on the left and one on the right. Place the needle on the middle line and pull around once. Draw an additional small circle around the center of the left circle and an even smaller one around the center of the right future hoop. Next to the left tire you draw a small circle for the chain ring with a little distance.


Step 3: Basic position of pannier rack, seat post, bicycle fork

You draw a line diagonally from the middle of each of the three circles to the top left with a pencil. The template will also help you here.




Step 4: Basic shape of the bicycle frame

Now use the pencil to draw in the positions of the handlebars, saddle, luggage rack, pedal arm and chain. The bike is now available as a rough line drawing.




Step 5: Lasting contours

You swap the pencil for the drawing pen and design the bicycle frame, the saddle, the handlebars, the chain and the luggage rack as in the template. In addition, you draw the pedals, the steering wheel handles and the light.



Step 6: Tires and other details

Now use the pencil to draw the tires and fenders.



Step 7: Spokes & Removal of Guide Lines

You draw the spokes in the wheels and add more details. You also remove the auxiliary lines with the eraser. You are now finished with the drawing.



Step 8: Coloring

You paint your bike in color. In the template, the frame is blue and the hoops are grey-brown. But you can also use other nuances.
