Giraffe drawing - step by step tutorial



A giraffe is a beautiful motif for your own children's room or also well suited as a representation of nature. The graceful animals exude calm and serenity and with these step-by-step instructions you can easily draw a lifelike giraffe and take over the positive energy for you. Use this template for birthday invitations, wall decals, or picture stories.

⚠ For the drawing you need a pencil, an eraser, a drawing pen and suitable colors according to your personal taste.



Step 1: Head and snout


First, use the pencil to draw two circles that mark the giraffe's head.

Step 2: Body

Mark the body of the animal with two larger oblique ovals. Pay attention to the right size and the distance and use the pencil first.




Step 3: Neck and Tail

Now use curved lines to sketch the body, neck and head of the animal. Note the slight hump through the shoulder blades.



Step 4: Limbs


Now use the pencil to draw the long legs of the giraffe. Maintain a natural posture. Use small circles to show the joints where the legs are slightly bent and already indicate the hooves.



Step 5: First lasting contours


From now on, use a drawing pen. Use it to first trace the head, the body and the tail line. Add the first details to the head.






Step 6: Silence and Face

Use the pencil to complete the legs, tail and face. Add a short mane.



Step 7: Remove the

guidelines Carefully erase the underlying pencil drawing and any guidelines.



Step 8: Coloring

In the last step you can colorize your giraffe. By shading or using light and dark colors, you can achieve a three-dimensional effect that makes the giraffe look even more realistic.
