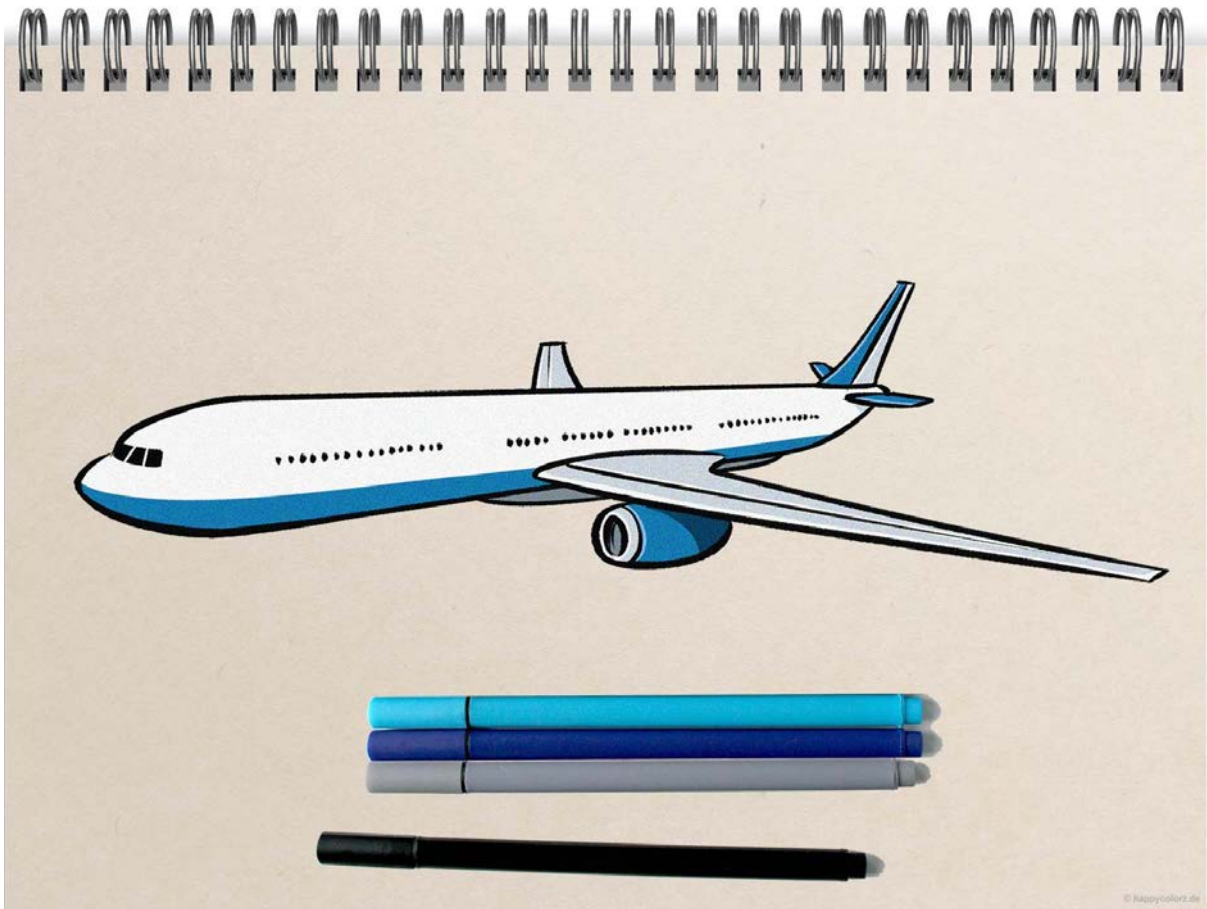


How to draw a plane - step by step tutorial



Drawing an airplane doesn't have to be difficult! With the help of these instructions, a sleek airplane is created step by step.

⚠ For this drawing, we recommend a pencil (e.g. HB or H2), eraser, ruler, drawing pen and colored pencils of your own taste.

Step 1: Auxiliary line Use

the pencil to draw a straight line that runs slightly diagonally upwards. You are welcome to use a ruler for this.

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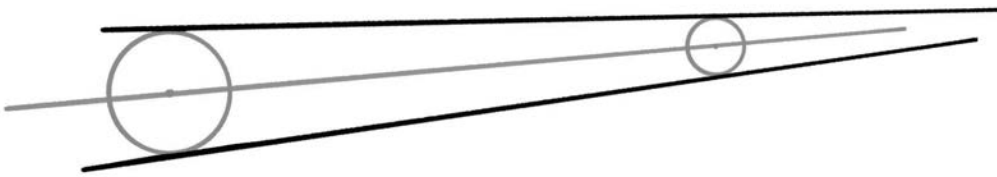


Step 2: Circumference of the

torso In the front and back third, draw small circles around the line with the pencil. The front circle is larger than the back. Look carefully at the template to position the circles correctly.

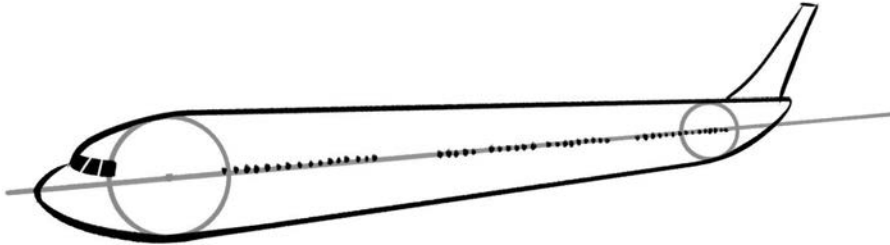


Step 3: Remaining contours

You now connect the circles at the top and bottom with a line each. A streamlined body is created - the aircraft fuselage. If you want, you can already draw the lines with the pen, because they will be retained later.

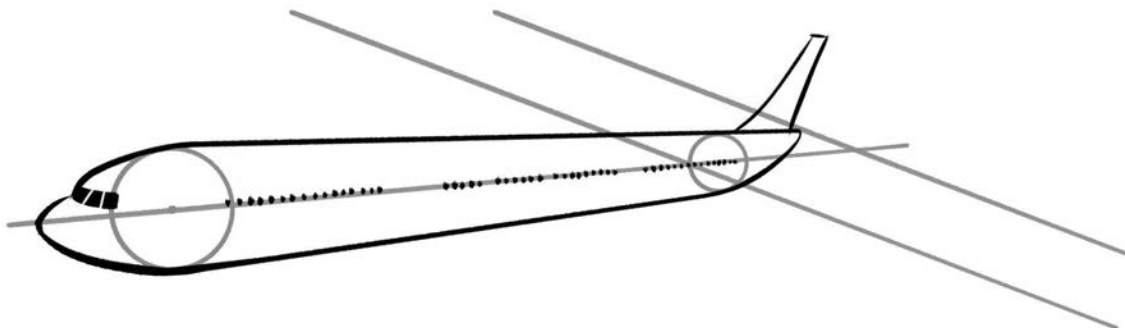


Step 4: Bow, windows and tail fin

In front of the left circle, use the pencil to draw the "nose" of the airplane with the windows for the cockpit. You also design the rear part with the tail fin. Then you place the passenger windows along the center line. If the shapes fit, trace the outer contours with the drawing pen.

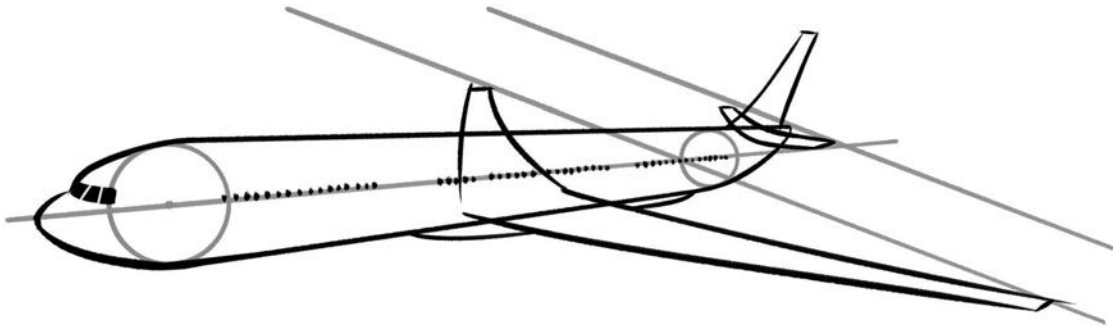


Step 5: More auxiliary lines for the wings

Now take the pencil again and draw two parallel auxiliary lines in the rear part of the aircraft, running diagonally from the bottom right to the top left.

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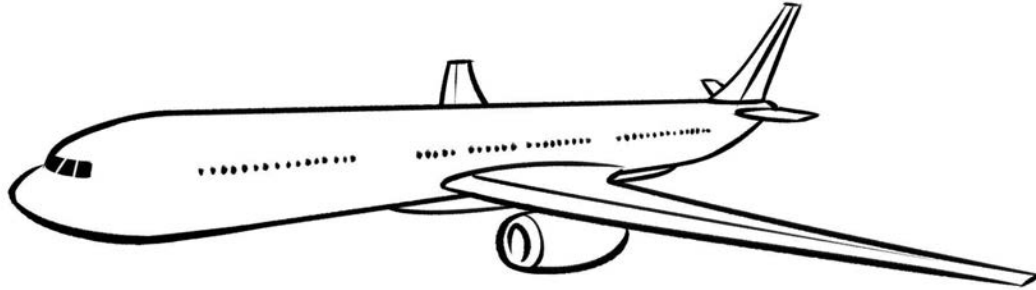


Step 6: Wings

Place the transversal tailplane (at the back of the tail) under the vertical stabilizer. Then you begin to draw the wings, orienting yourself on the auxiliary line drawn in step 5.

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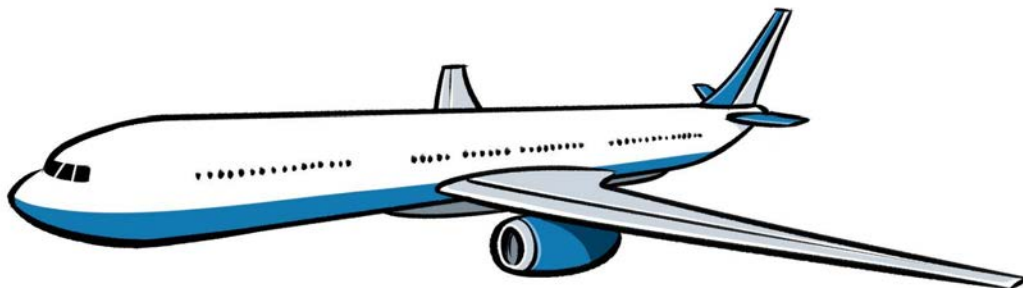


Step 7: Remove the auxiliary lines

Use the drawing pen to outline the contours and create further details, as shown in the template. Then you remove all auxiliary lines.

Step 8: Color

When you're done drawing, color in your plane. In the example, the plane is blue and white. But you are welcome to use other colors.
