Princess drawing - step by step tutorial



With the help of this guide you can draw a beautiful princess step by step.

⚠ You will need a hard, erasable pencil (HB or H2), an eraser, an erasable drawing pen and colored pencils.



Step 1: Head and Torso

You start at the top with the head. To do this, draw a circle with a pencil. Underneath you put a triangle pointing downwards.



Step 2: The Dress

At the bottom of the triangle, draw the bell-shaped skirt. Make sure it's symmetrical. If you don't succeed right away, then you take the eraser and touch up the lines.



Step 3: Arms and Hands

Your princess will have arms. Mark shoulders, elbows and wrists with small circles. You connect these with lines. You also indicate the hands in this way.



Step 4: First final contours

Now you take the pen to hand. With it you draw the permanent contours. A fine fiber pen, for example, is suitable for this. You trace the silhouette of the head and shape the neck with the shoulders. The arms now get their final shape by connecting the shoulders, elbows and wrists in a sweeping manner. This template shows you how to do this. You also indicate the course of the hair with the pencil.

Step 5: Completing the silhouette Use

the drawing pencil to shape the dress from the armpits over the waist to the bell-shaped skirt. You give the hem a lively wave shape.



Step 6: Important details for the face, décolleté, crown and dress

You now go into detail and work out the subtleties. Your princess gets a face, a sophisticated cleavage and a crown. You also set visual accents with the dress. Just let yourself be inspired by the instructions.

Step 7: Removing all auxiliary lines

You use the pen to trace over all the lines that you want to remain visible. Then erase the pencil lines. Now the princess is only missing the color.

You take the colored pencils and color in the princess. In the template, the princess is blonde and wears a red dress. But you are welcome to use other colors.
