
Shark drawing - step by step tutorial



With these instructions, you will be able to draw a shark realistically step by step.

⚠ For this drawing, we recommend a hard, easily erasable pencil, an erasable drawing pen, a ruler, and paint right.

Step 1: Auxiliary line


You take the pencil and draw a straight line across the page. Ideally, use a ruler for this.


Step 2: Torso

Above and below the line, draw a slightly curved line. You get a streamlined body.




Step 3: Fins, Gills and Eyes

With a few simple strokes you can create a fish. With short curved lines you indicate the dorsal and side fins as well as the tail. In addition, the shark gets its gill slits and side-seated eye.




Step 4: First final contours

If you like, you can now grab the drawing pen. You give the shark shape by further developing the fins and giving the animal an elegantly curved shape. The part above the auxiliary line is now finished.




Step 5: More fins, mouth and teeth

Now it's time for the lower part. You devote yourself to the opposite ventral fin and the smaller fins. You finish drawing the tail. In addition, your shark gets its slanted backwards mouth with its teeth.




Step 6: Sideline

We draw the final detail! The shark gets a lateral line that runs just above the snout and across the belly. The template shows you the position.



Step 7: Remove the guidelines

You erase the pencil lines and the finished shark sketch is in front of you!



Step 8: Coloring

Now color comes into play. Color the belly with the mouth part light blue. The back is medium and dark blue. Look carefully at the template. Some areas are painted lighter, others darker. The darker areas are in the shadows, the lighter ones in the light. You can also see irregular white lines at the top of the back that simulate the reflection of light. Follow the instructions and create a vivid picture.
