
#### **Ship drawing - step by step tutorial**



A ship, more precisely a sailing ship, embodies the dream of tranquility and luxury on the sea. To draw such a ship, you need a loose stroke, because although it is a clearly structured object, the soft and somewhat curved lines of a sailing ship are captivating.

With these instructions you can draw a dreamlike ship step by step and set sail in your mind. Use the template, for example, for a beautiful drawing for a birthday or as a cool wall tattoo.


⚠ We recommend a pencil, an eraser, an erasable drawing pen and matching colors according to your preferences for this tutorial.

## **Step 1: The Deck**

Start your ship with a delicate and slightly curved line that will be the boundary for the deck. Please use the pencil first.



# **Step 2: The Masts**

Place two lines on the deck that will later be worked out into the sail masts. Make sure to leave a small gap to the deck line you drew first.





## **Step 3: The Waterline**


with the pencil and outline the body of the sailboat. Be sure to leave an overhang at the bow. It later forms the jib boom on which the front sail is tensioned.






## Step 4: The sails

Now create the sails with the pencil. The front sail runs directly towards the tip of the jib boom.




**Step 5: The Upper Deck and Control** 

Room Sketch the upper deck and windows of the control room and the boom for attaching the aft sail.



**Step 6: First permanent contours** 

Now use the pencil to trace the ship and add the first details. Make sure that the front sail billows in the wind so that the ship is also visibly moving.



**Step 7: Remove the** 

guidelines Carefully erase the underlying pencil drawing and add final details such as windows and rigging.



**Step 8: Coloring** 

In the last step you can colorize your ship.
