
# Strawberries drawing - step by step tutorial



The strawberry is loved by most people and is very easy to draw. Simply use the following instructions, which will take you step by step to the finished sweet fruit. For this drawing you need a pencil, a black drawing pen, a red, yellow and a green crayon or colored pencil. Here's how it works:




## **Step 1: Final width of the fruit**

Draw an oval as shown in the picture. The oval should be open at the top center-left.



Step 2: Basic shape

Attach a kind of inverted and slightly rounded cone or a large "V" to the oval.




**Step 3: Remaining contours and stem** 

Use the black pencil to trace the contours you have set so far. The lower half of the oval drawn first is only left as an auxiliary line; do not trace it in black. Give the strawberry a stalk on top.




**Step 4: The goblet** 

Now draw the green around the stalk, the shape of which is typical for strawberries.



## **Step 5: Berry surface**

Now the strawberries get their little seeds! You can place these irregularly on the berry surface. In addition, the green is accentuated a little so that it looks more natural.



#### **Step 6: Coloring**

Now color the strawberry in the colors you are used to. The flesh of the fruit turns red, the base of the leaf turns green, and the seeds appear yellow. If everything worked out, the appetite for fresh strawberries should now set in!
