

Unicorn drawing - step by step tutorial



A unicorn isn't just the dream of little girls. The graceful mythical creatures enchant big and small and stand for magic and the courage to be different. Drawing a wonderful unicorn is not difficult at all with the right tricks. This guide will show you step-by-step how to do this. You can also use them as a template for drawing a horse.

⚠ For the drawing you need a pencil, an eraser, an erasable drawing pen and suitable colors according to your preferences. You can use a pair of compasses for the circles, but freehand circles are usually sufficient for animal drawings. Otherwise, they quickly look too artificial.

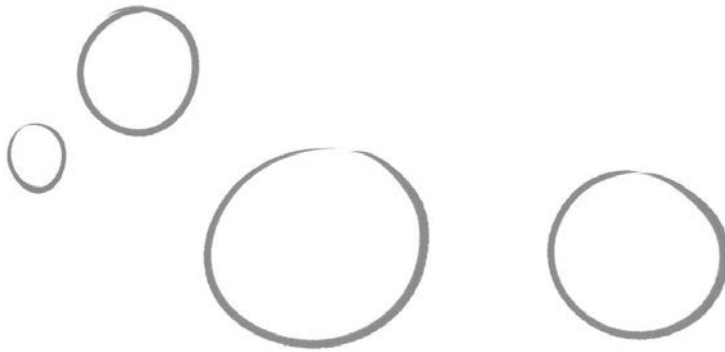
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Step 1: Head and snout

First draw two circles with the pencil to define the future head of the animal. If you want your unicorn to end up white, the pencil lines need to be very thin so that they completely disappear after erasing.

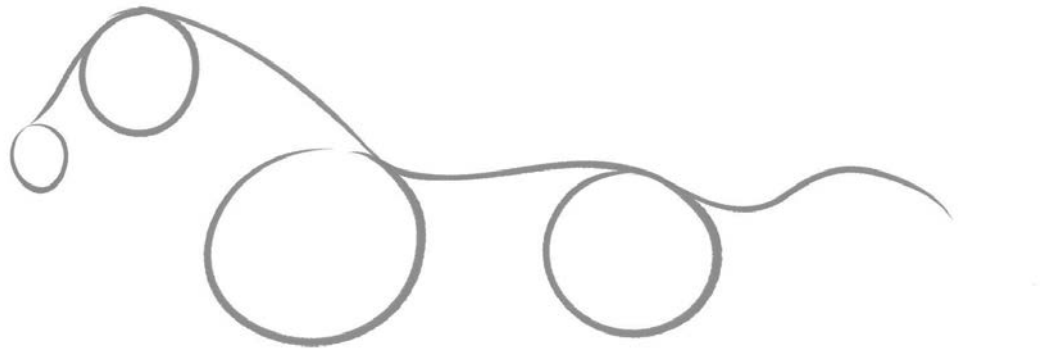
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Step 2: Torso

Use two larger circles to mark the prominent points on the torso where the strong muscles are located.

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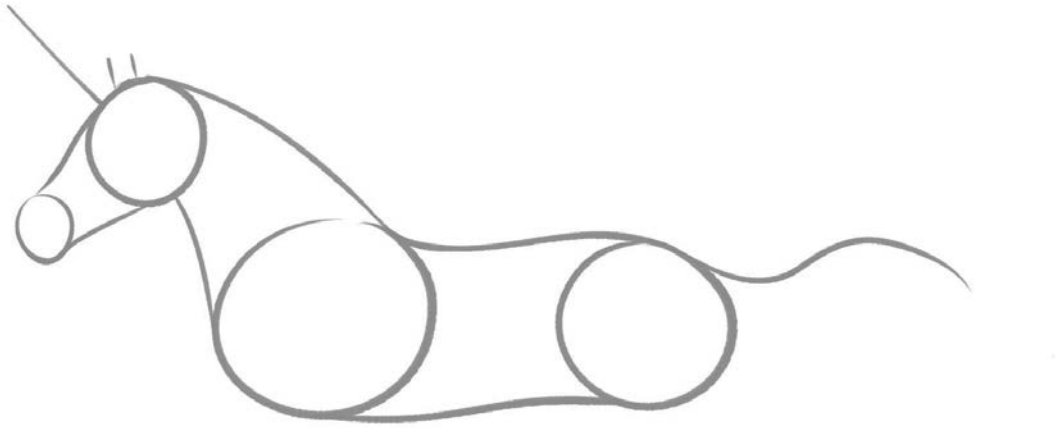


Step 3: Neck, Back and Tail

Now use a continuous curved line to sketch the animal's nose, neck, back and tail. Make sure that the course is natural and not too straight.

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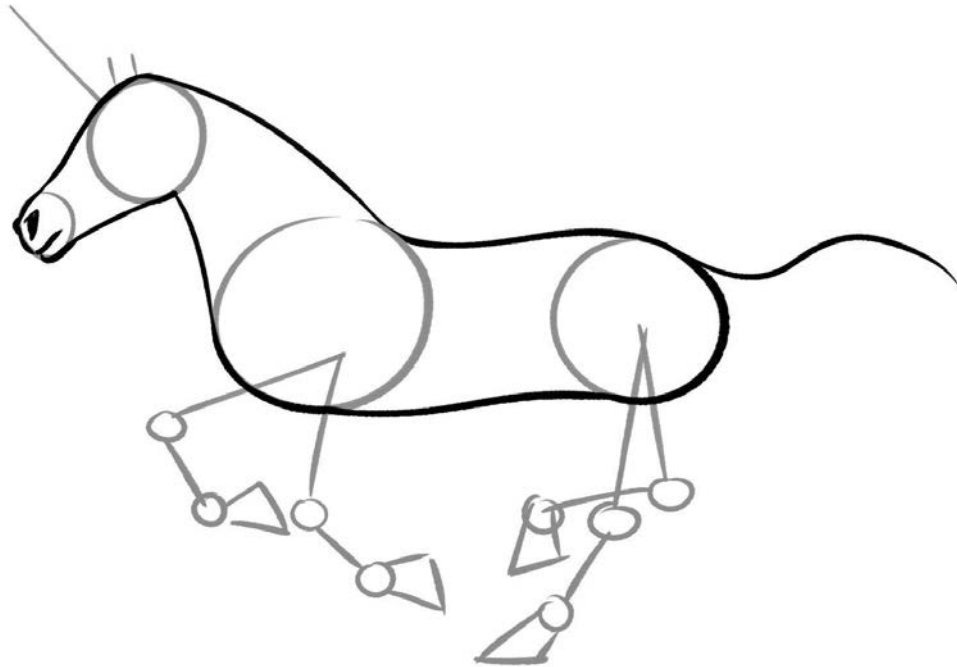


Step 4: Horn and Chest

Complete the sketch of the torso and head, already marking the position for the horn.

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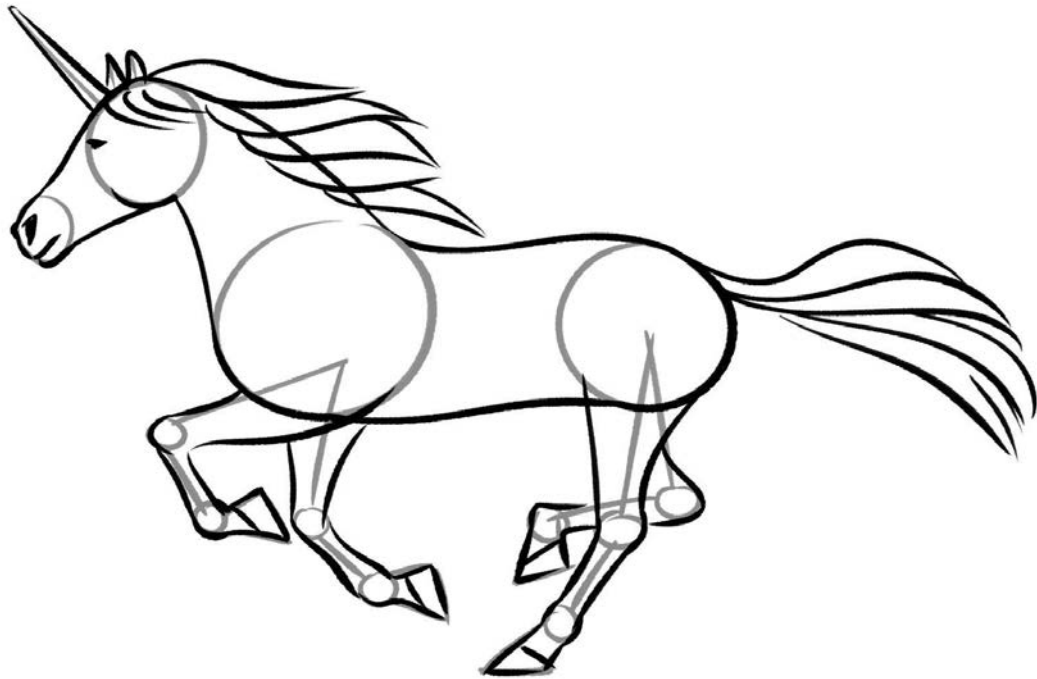
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Step 5: Limbs and first permanent contours

Now sketch the legs in a gallop. Maintain a natural posture. Use small circles to show the joints where the legs are bent and already indicate the hooves. Then use a drawing pen and start by tracing the head, the body and the tail line. Add the first details to the head.

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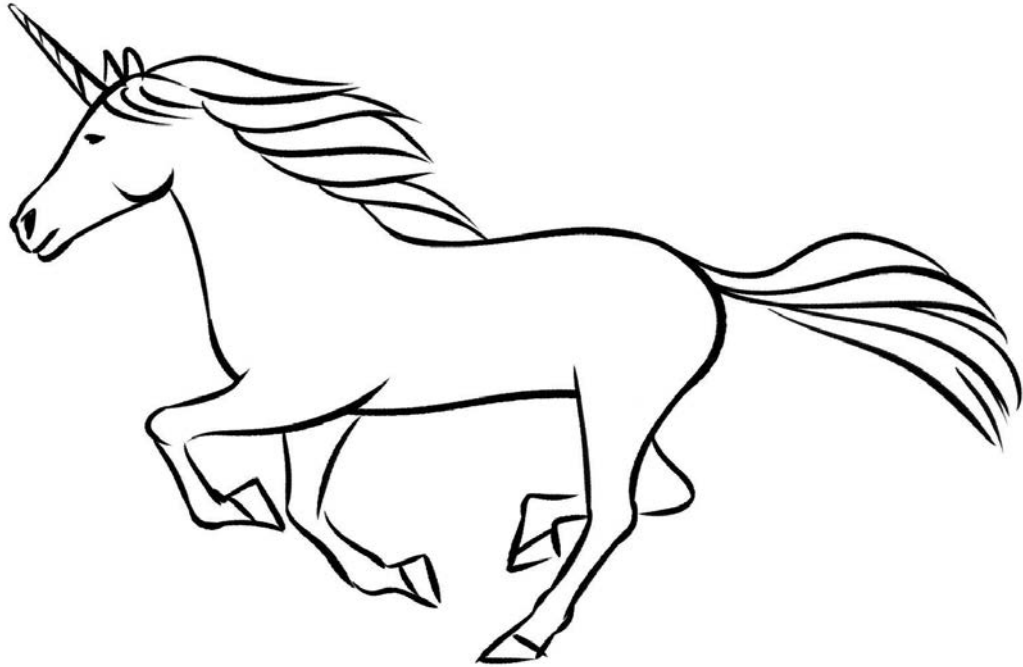


Step 6: Mane and other details

Use the pencil to complete the legs and face. Add a flowing mane and draw a flowing tail.

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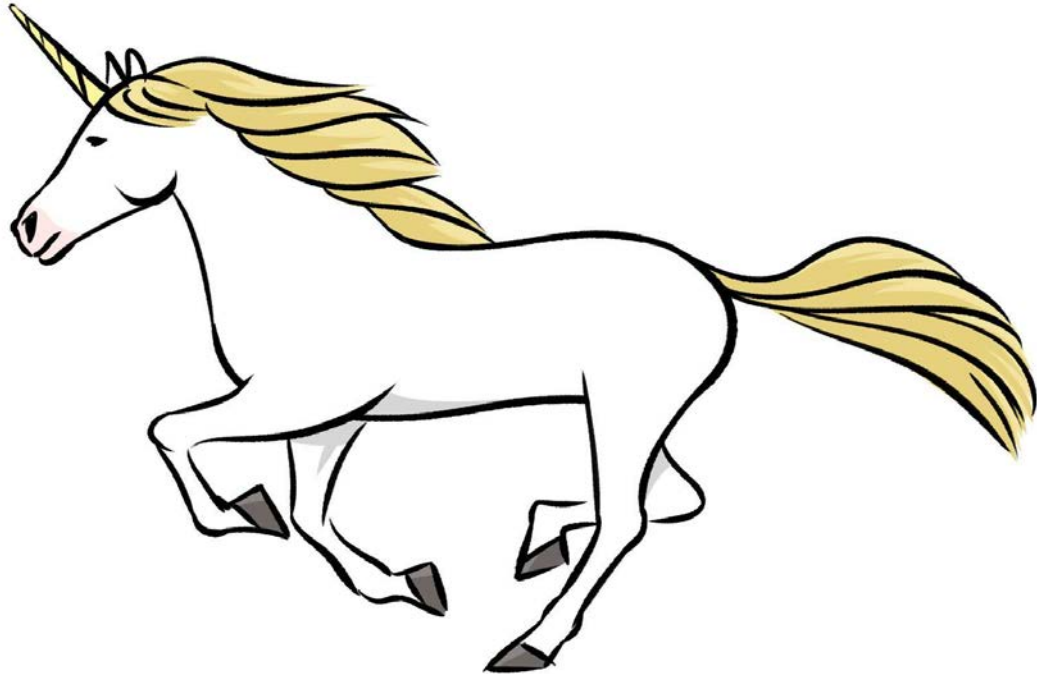
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Step 7: Remove the

guidelines Carefully erase the underlying pencil drawing and any guidelines.

Step 8: Coloring

In the last step you can colorize your unicorn. By shading or using light and dark colors you can create a three-dimensional effect and make the unicorn look even more realistic.
